1. Abstracts must be submitted in English, using this form at this email ID mrkdeep@gmail.com
2. All the Abstracts need to be clearly marked as **Podium or Poster or both** at the TOP
3. Please ensure that the abstracts are prepared in the format as instructed
4. **DO NOT TYPE IN CAPITALS.** The Society reserves the right to change the formatting of abstracts submitted in upper case or where the abstract title is typed in upper case, to be consistent with the requirements of the Meeting Programme: it cannot be held responsible for any possible loss of meaning that results. Please do not give any indication in the abstract regarding where the scientific work submitted was carried out.
5. The presenting author must be underlined, to whom all correspondence will be sent.
6. Abstracts must be received by close of business (5.00pm) on or before 31st March 2012 and must not exceed 250 words.
7. Once submitted and received by the Secretariat, it will not be possible to alter the abstract or list of authors. Your submitted abstract alone will be used to judge the quality of your work and will be published in the Meeting Programme, **so it is important to make it as good as possible at this stage.**
8. **Abstracts will be considered anonymously by the Programme Scientific Committee** and the author will receive acceptance/rejection notification, and further correspondence as applicable. The Programme Committee favours original work of any complexity that has not been published previously. To impress the Committee and to improve usefulness of the Meeting Programme, authors should use these or similar headings to arrange the abstract clearly:

Introduction/Aims
Material/Methods
Results/Statistics
Conclusions/Clinical Reference

9. For presentation of numeric data, please use **TABLES** and/or **CHARTS** where possible, if this enhances comprehension of the paper.
10. **POSTER SUBMISSION** – The Society wishes to improve the merit of poster presentations. Poster abstracts should be submitted on the form below and will be published in the meeting programme. Please use the same general advice and format as for free paper presentations
11. Posters will be selected in a separate category to free paper presentations. Posters will be given a prominent position in the meeting hall. Presenters will be asked to stand by their work to answer questions during breaks at a time which will be advised. A4 size handouts should be prepared for interested delegates. A prize will be awarded for the best poster.
12. The Society endeavours to notify authors of success or failure of submissions as quickly as possible. Please refrain from telephoning the Secretariat for this information unless it is a matter of extreme urgency. **You will receive an e-mail confirming receipt when your abstract arrives in the Secretariat.** This will be sent to the address * you supply on this form. If you do not receive confirmation of receipt within 5 days of submission please contact the Secretariat.
13. Those authors whose abstracts are accepted must register to attend the conference and pay a registration fee. A programme and registration form will be posted on the website.
14. All abstracts accepted for podium presentation only are likely to be published in the JBJS(Br). Only abstracts which have not been accepted as publications anywhere else should be submitted
15. Abstracts withdrawn from a meeting or not selected will **NOT** be automatically considered for the next Scientific Meeting, but can be resubmitted.
16. The decision regarding acceptance/rejection will be conveyed to the first author/email id supplied by 25th of May 2012
17. **The presenting author register for the meeting within the first week of the abstract/poster being accepted otherwise it would be withdrawn by the Programme committee.**
